1. General Information About the Book of the Month

- Revelation is a book of prophecy where the divine message is conveyed by visions and dreams
- A "Revelation" from God, to Jesus, to the apostle John of things to come – a revealing, unveiling, explaining, making known, of things that are in the future
- The Book of Revelations is known as the Apocalypse – Greek – meaning uncovering
- Revelation – Latin – meaning uncovering
- The book is an "uncovering" of the age to come, of the final victory of God and the Lamb, Jesus
- Full of references to the Old Testament books of Ezekiel, Daniel and Zechariah
